Some key points from this year's finances:

- At the beginning of the year we had \$279.95 set aside as part of our cash balance for future CPR and First Aid Training from a previous donation from IBEW. \$40 was used for training this year, leaving a balance of \$239.95 set aside (from the total cash balance) specifically for CPR and First Aid Training for our members.
- \$1,000 of the cash balance is to be set aside for advertising and recruitment purposes, from a previous donation from Busch Systems

The Club received \$1,000 in sponsorship dollars from Moore Packaging, to be used as follows:

 \$1,000 sponsorship of the Moore Dragonslayers dragon boat team, for the Barrie Dragon Boat Festival

The club also received private donations covering the costs of the website, and advertising costs.

What do these membership fees cover?

There are a number of costs involved with running the Club, some of which are broken down as follows:

- Dragon Boat Canada membership totaled \$113.00
- Insurance costs totaled \$1,439.10
- TeamSnap \$950.01
- Bank fees of \$120.60
- Website costs of approximately \$250 were donated in kind

After all club costs are considered, the membership fees paid in 2023 have not covered our total administrative expenses, however it is very close.

2024 Season Plan
